

Rachel Kentor, PhD is an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at Baylor College of Medicine/Texas Children's Hospital, where she works as a pediatric psychologist specializing in oncology, palliative care, and grief and bereavement. She earned her undergraduate degree at the University of Iowa before pursuing a Master of Science and doctorate in Clinical Psychology at Eastern Michigan University. She completed her predoctoral internship and postdoctoral fellowship in Pediatric Psychology at Baylor College of Medicine/Texas Children's Hospital. Dr. Kentor has presented her research nationally and internationally, with a focus on illness-related communication with pediatric patients, impact of family functioning on child adjustment to disease, and anticipatory grief among dying children and their families.
